Summary of other comments:

- Participants praised the plenary sessions and many of the other contributions, which they thought were of high relevance, although it was also pointed out that some presentations had no relationship with the title of the conference. Having only two parallel sessions was positively valued. It was also suggested that there should be more time for questions; *“I would like to see a Q&A session built into the end of every session. Some sessions ended early and there was time for this which was useful and interesting/clarifying”*.
- Rooms were found to be generally too hot, with some additional acoustics problems.
- Online access to presentations was asked for, in order to be able to have access to the presentations missed. *[This is provided on the EALTA website together with this report.]*
- There were some requests for the participants’ e-mails/institutions on participants list, although those asking for that were aware of the possible difficulties in getting the agreement of participants.
